Definitions:

Positive person: Anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 with either an antigen or PCR test within the past 10 days.

Close Contact: Anyone who was within 6 feet of a positive person for a cumulative 15 minutes over a 24 hour period during their infectious period.

Infectious period: 48 hours prior to and including the day symptoms began and 8-10 subsequent days. If the positive person has no symptoms, the infectious period is 48 hours prior to and including the day that the positive test was taken and 8-10 days afterwards.

Possible exposure: Individual was present near a positive person but was not confirmed as a close contact through contact investigation.

Quarantine: Unvaccinated students/staff must stay home and get tested for COVID-19 5 days after last contact with a positive case. If any symptoms develop, they must immediately self-isolate and get tested for COVID-19 or be evaluated by a healthcare provider. The student/staff may return to school/work on Day 8 after last exposure with a negative test (antigen or molecular) if they remain without symptoms.

Students/staff in quarantine should continue to monitor symptoms for 14 days after the exposure. If there is ongoing exposure in the home and the positive case cannot isolate away from family members, unvaccinated students/staff may need to quarantine for an extended amount of time. Please consult with public health for more information.

Modified Quarantine: TK-12 school aged students may attend school, ride the bus, and attend before-/after-care programs for in-person instruction and child care as long as they do not develop symptoms, wear a mask, monitor for symptoms for 14 days and get tested for COVID-19 5 days after last contact with positive case (or return from out-of-state travel). If any symptoms develop, students should immediately self-isolate and get tested for COVID-19 or be evaluated by a healthcare provider. Modified Quarantine may be discontinued after 7 days with a negative test completed on Day 5 or later if they remain without symptoms. During modified quarantine students should refrain from socializing outside of school and going out in public.

Monitor: Monitor symptoms for 14 days; Test at Day 5 recommended. If any symptoms develop, immediately self-isolate and get tested for COVID-19 or be evaluated by a healthcare provider.

High-risk activities: Activities in which increased exhalation occurs, such as activities that involve singing, shouting, band, or exercise, especially when conducted *indoors*.

High-risk sports: basketball, boxing, field hockey, football, ice hockey, lacrosse, martial arts, rowing (non-singles), rugby, soccer, squash, volleyball, water polo, and wrestling.

Template Letters are a strongly recommended means of communicating with families/staff, but are not required.

- Unvaccinated close contact of a household member who tested positive for COVID-19
- Unvaccinated person in a childcare setting (0 4 years old)
- Unvaccinated person who had unmasked close contact during indoor lunch
- Unvaccinated person who traveled out-of-state
- Unvaccinated person exposed unmasked during carpool (>15 min). TBC

Modified Quarantine (Test on Day 5 Required)

- Unvaccinated student with possible unmasked exposure at indoor high-risk activity (see list on page 1) [not a confirmed close contact]
- Unvaccinated student with confirmed close contact during outdoor lunch
- Unvaccinated student who traveled out-of-state
- Unvaccinated student exposed masked during carpool. TBC

Monitor for Symptoms (Test on Day 5 Recommended)

- Vaccinated person with close contact to a household member who tested positive for COVID-19 (*case must be able to isolate).
- Vaccinated person with close contact at a childcare facility.
- Vaccinated student with confirmed close contact during indoor and outdoor lunch.
- Unvaccinated and vaccinated students with undetermined contact during outdoor lunch.
- Unvaccinated student with undetermined close contact during indoor lunch
- Unvaccinated person with possible masked exposure at indoor high-risk activity (see list below) [not a confirmed close contact].
- Unvaccinated person with possible unmasked exposure at outdoor high-risk activity (see list below) [not a confirmed close contact].
- Vaccinated close contact at a high-risk sports/music activity.
- Unvaccinated person with possible exposure at indoor low-moderate risk activity (masked or unmasked)

• Vaccinated person exposed during carpool > 15 minutes (unmasked).

Exposure Notice - Symptomatic Testing

- Unvaccinated person with possible exposure at *outdoor* high-risk activity [not a confirmed close contact] Both positive and exposed persons are masked
- Unvaccinated and vaccinated persons with possible exposure at outdoor low-moderate risk activity (masked or unmasked)
- Vaccinated person with possible exposure at indoor low-moderate risk activity (masked or unmasked)
- Vaccinated person with undetermined contact during indoor lunch.
- Vaccinated person exposed during carpool > 15 minutes (masked).
